



SLVMC, Arunachal Pradesh opens to public grievance

With a view to ensure quality of expenditure of large public funds, being spent under various schemes and programmes of Union Rural Development Ministry, **State Level Vigilance & Monitoring Committee (SLVMC), Arunachal Pradesh** would soon start off the block through people's participation in the system.

In this context, general public can lodge complaint (if any), to the **Monitoring Committee** on misappropriation of funds, wrong selection of beneficiary, diversion of funds, low quality of works etc. They may also lodge complaint on the RD schemes like **NREGA, SGSY, IAY, PMGSY, DRDA Administration, Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP), National Land Records Modernization Programme (NLRMP), Accelerated Rural Water Supply Programme (ARWSP), Rural Sanitation Programme and National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP)**, in case of any violation of norms by the executing agency/department.



This effort has been taken, in order to monitor the execution of the schemes with an effective and efficient manner, so that public funds will put to optimal use and the benefits of these programmes will reach to the rural area rapidly. This will also help in making the level of co-ordination between the concerned State Department and Union Ministry, very strong.
