



Ramle Academic Campus inaugurated at Telam of Arunachal

Ramle Academic Campus and the Gomik Dabi Rest House at Telam Government Higher Secondary School were inaugurated in the State of Arunachal Pradesh by Hon'ble Home Minister, Arunachal Pradesh on 21st of this month. This Rest House has been named after Gomik Dabi, who was the first public leader during the North East Frontier Agency (NEFA) days and was the founder member of "Adi Parliament Bogam Boka" in early 40s'.

Besides these, the Shiva Temple near the Nari Police Station of Namey Village was also inaugurated on that day. At the Public Meeting arranged in the Dabi Memorial Hall of Namey village, Hon'ble Home Minister addressed the large no. of public and alerted about maintaining harmony and peace within the State. He further urged upon all to nurture the Dignity of Labour, which should be the '*mantra*' to overcome all the failures and sufferings of human beings.
