**EMPANELMENT OF CHEMISTS FOR ESIC DISPENSARIES OF U.T. CHANDIGARH.**

Applications are invited from reputed Local Chemists at Chandigarh for empanelment for the supply of medicines to the ESIC Dispensaries of U.T. Chandigarh.

The application should be submitted in Duplicate along with Tender Form. The Tender Form can be obtained from the office of Planning Officer, GMSH-16, Chandigarh. Each tender document should accompany the proof for deposit of Rs. 400/- as Tender fee or as cost of Tender.

Minimum requirements for eligibility:-

1. The chemist must hold valid licenses as on the date of Bid opening in specified forms (Form 20,20-B, 21, 21-B and 21-C) for various categories of allopathic drugs issued by the Drug Control Authority of the State under the provisions of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940. The successful Bidder will further ensure that their licenses remain valid till the end of the contract period.
2. The chemist must not have been convicted by the State drugs authorities and no case should be pending under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act and Rules made there under.
3. The annual turnover of the bidder should be Rs. 15-20 lacs during the last three financial years.
4. The chemist shop/ commercial establishment should be within 02 kilometers distance by shortest motorable route from the dispensaries/ group of dispensaries.
5. In such cities where dispensaries are clubbed into groups, the group details will be given as an Annexure to this Tender. The bidding shall be for a group and not dispensary wise. The bidders can quote for a group only if their commercial establishment/ chemist shop is located within 02 (two) kilometers of the dispensary (s). If there is no eligible bidder for a group, the contract may be awarded to the empanelled chemist of the next nearest group.
6. VAT clearance certificate should be available with the bidder.
7. A copy of PAN allotted to the firm.

The Director Health & Family Welfare, U.T. Chandigarh reserves the right to reject all/ any application received from the Chemists without assigning any reason.

Application along with the Bid documents duly filled in should be submitted to the Office of the Dy. Medical Superintendent, Govt. Multi Speciality Hospital, Sector-16, Chandigarh on or before 22-9-2009 till 11.00 a.m.
