- I. - II. A candidate can apply on the single Application Form attached with the Prospectus for up to as many as eight programmes/courses. If, however, he/she wants to apply for more than eight programmes, then s/he shall have to procure a second copy of Prospectus containing application form. A candidate is required to deposit the entire amount of fee chargeable (for all programmes s/he is applying @ **Rs.245/= per programme**) through the Pay-in-Slip attached with the Application Form [and bearing the same Serial No. as on the Application Form] at any branch of the J&K Bank Ltd. having “Anywhere Banking” facility. Xeroxed copy of Application Form will not be accepted as it would not carry any distinct serial number and as such candidates are advised to fill in the Application Form and Pay-in-Slip very carefully, without overwriting and mutilation.
- III. Application Forms can also be downloaded from the official website of University of Kashmir www.kashmiruniversity.net. The downloaded Application Form also bears a distinct Serial No. and hence only original downloaded Forms (and not their photocopies) shall be used. In case the candidate is submitting a downloaded Application Form, s/he shall add the **cost of the Prospectus (i.e., Rs. 250/=)** to the total Entrance Fee to be deposited through the Pay-in-Slip.
- IV. No Application form shall be accepted unless it is appended with the attested copies of the following Certificates:
- Marks Certificates of the qualifying examination;
 - Reserved Category Certificates (if applicable) signed by the Competent Authority in respect of candidates seeking admission under Reserved Categories. The University shall not entertain the plea “Certificate Under Process” as already notified in the local press vide No: **F.(PG-Admission-2010) DAA/KU/2010 Dated: 5. 01. 2010.**
 - State Subject Certificate (if it is not available, a residence certificate signed by a Gazetted Officer should be appended)
 - Character Certificate if available (if not available the same shall have to be produced at the time of admission)
- Note:** In case a candidate has passed the qualifying examination from any Institution other than University of Kashmir, he/she shall have to submit Migration Certificate at the time of admission. Candidates presently serving in any Government/Semi-government or any other institution/organization shall be required to produce “**No Objection Certificate**” from their employer at the time of admission.

- V. In case of "Reserved Categories" if a candidate is eligible to apply for admission under more than one category, he/she shall be required to choose only one reserved category for one programme under which he/she would like to be considered, which shall be final, and unchangeable. However, such a candidate shall be at liberty to choose a different category in respect of another programme in which he / she is desirous to seek admission. For example, if a candidate is eligible under RBA, NCC as well as Sports categories, he shall have to choose only one of the three categories under which he shall compete for admission for a particular programme. Say, if he is an applicant for PG programmes in A, B, C and D subjects, he may compete in all the Courses only under one of these three categories (RBA, NCC or Sports, whichever he likes) or he may compete (say for instance) under RBA for A, under NCC for B, under Sports for C and under RBA for D. He is not, however, permitted to compete under more than one category for a single programme; i.e. he cannot for instance apply under RBA as well as NCC for a single programme.
- VI. Candidates belonging to Gojjar & Bakarwal Category shall be required to clearly specify whether admission is being sought under 'Scheduled Tribe Category' or under 'Gojjar & Bakarwal Category'.
- VII. A candidate can simultaneously pursue a full-time P G Programme and one part-time Certificate Course.
- VIII. For admission to the programmes MCA, MA English, M Sc Home Science (Human Development), MA/M Sc Mathematics, M Sc Chemistry, M Sc Environmental Science, MA/M Sc Geography, M Com and LLB” offered at the University Main Campus, Hazratbal as well as at University Satellite Campus/es (South Campus, Fatehgarh, Anantnag and/or North Campus, Delina, Baramulla) and/or some affiliated Colleges (details available in the Prospectus 2010), the applicant has to indicate in the application form his/her order of preference for the Campus/Institution where s/he would like to study in case of her/his admission to the said programme. For example if a post-graduate programme (say M A in subject X) is offered at three places, Campus A, Campus B and College I, the applicant may give his/her order of preference in any one (a, b or c) of the following ways.

- IX. Candidates are, in their own interest, advised to consult the University Prospectus 2010 for detailed guidelines regarding eligibility and other conditions for admission to various Programmes before filling in the Application Form. Application Form complete in all respects, together with J & K Bank receipt on the Pay-in-slip (attached with the Application form) for the **Entrance Test Fee @ Rs. 245.00 per programme** and necessary Certificates shall be deposited by or before **1st March, 2010** (up to 4.30pm) in any one of the Postgraduate Departments/Institutes of the University of Kashmir, Main Campus, Hazratbal, where s/he is an applicant. The receipt of the Application shall be issued by the concerned Department on the back side of the Depositor's copy of the Pay-in-Slip.

- X. Applicants are advised to remain in touch with the respective Departments and follow all the University Notifications/Announcements regarding admission to various programmes/courses. They can also check the status of the Application, Admit card, Centre notice, date of Entrance Test, Result status, etc., from the official website of the University www.kashmiruniversity.net.
- XI. Candidates already possessing a Masters degree in one subject are eligible to apply for admission to another PG programme or a Diploma/Certificate Course, if s/he fulfills the eligibility conditions prescribed by the University. However, such candidates shall not be entitled to accommodation in the University Hostels.
- XII. The eligible candidates shall be required to appear in an Entrance Test (if needed) to be conducted by the university for the purpose where they shall have to attempt sixty multiple choice objective type questions carrying a total of sixty marks uniformly spread over the entire syllabus of the B A/ B Sc/B Com three-year degree programme in the subject in which they desire to seek admission. In case of programmes like LLB, PGDCA, MCA, M Sc. Biochemistry, M Sc Environmental Science, M LIS, M Sc, Biotechnology, M A Mass Communication-Journalism, M A Social Work, MA Linguistics, M Sc Home Science, M. Sc. Geo-informatics and M Sc Statistics, the question paper shall be broadly based on the guidelines/syllabi prescribed in Annexure II of the Prospectus. For admission to PG Diploma in Remote Sensing and GIS, candidates shall be selected on the basis of merit obtained by them in the qualifying examination.
- XIII. Candidates are expected to mark the correct or most appropriate response to the given questions. There shall be provision for negative marking whereby for each wrong answer, 0.25 marks shall be deducted towards the final tally of marks secured by a candidate.
- XIV. Notification inviting applications for admission against Self Financed Seats shall be issued separately.
- XV. Admission Notification in respect of other Programmes offered by the University shall be issued separately in due course of time.
- XVI. Notification regarding Centre Notice and Dates of Entrance Test shall be notified separately.
