S.No	Name of the Item	Specification.
1.	Pickle Mixer	Capacity 50 Kg. Made of SS 304 Mounted on M.S Frame Equipped with 1 HP 3 phase Motor V type tiltable drum with rotating blades to mix ingredients
2.	Pasteurizer	Capacity 200-500 LPH Suitable for Fruit Juice pasteurization. Provided with SS pump-,3 phase Motor, steam pressure and outlet temperature gauges.
3.	Hydraulic Juice Press	Basket type suitable for extraction of juice from hard and soft fruits.(Without Rack & Cloth) Equipped with 3 phase, Motor and Hydraulic pump with automatic pressure control devices.
4.	Centrifuge	Basket type made of stainless steel provided with 3 phase 1 HP Motor for High speed Centrifugation to separate pulpy material from the fruit and vegetable juices.
5.	Homogenizer	Discharge capacity 100-200 LPH Pressure 100-200 Bar Double stage fitted with 3 phase Motor With all other necessary accessories Required for Homogenization of fruit/vegetable juices and purees.

Annexure –II

Terms and Conditions

- 1. Validity:** The rates quoted shall be valid up to 30-06-2010 from the date of its issuance.
- 2. Terms of delivery.**
 - a) Delivery of items shall be made as per the rates approved.
 - b) Increasing in prices during the valid period shall not be considered.
 - c) Delivery of items shall be made FOR Division of PHT SKUAST-K Shalimar
 - d) For imported items if any custom clearance ,agent charges shall have to be borne by the suppliers and freight to be paid up to consignee's destination
- 3. Excise Duty:** The University is registered with department of scientific and Industrial research (DSIR), Ministry of Sciences and Technology, Govt of India under registration No.TU/V/RG/CDE(809)2005 dated August 25th 2005 and has been exempted from payment of excise duty on items listed in Govt notification No.10/97 Central excise dated March 1,1997 As amended from time to time. Thus no excise duty shall be paid by the university for such items.
- 4. Customs duty :**The University is registered with DSIR and has been exempted from payment of customs duty in terms of Government Notification No. 51/96 customs dated July 23, 1996 as amended from time to time.
- 5. Other Taxes:** As applicable at the time of delivery of the items.
- 6. Delivery Period:** Supply order shall be executed within 2 weeks after receipt of the supply order.
- 7. No advance payment shall be made.**
- 8. Payment of bills for supplies made shall be released subject to following conditions:**
 - a) The equipment/ apparatus supplied is strictly as per the make /model/ specifications as indicated in the supply order.
 - b) The working /performance of the equipments/items is demonstrated to the satisfaction of the verification committee constituted for the purpose by the competent authority of the University. The payment will be released after the afore mentioned committee records a certificate that “The equipment/item has been duly inspected and found as per the specification and model or make

ordered for and has shown satisfactory working and performance during demonstration.

9. The installation of the equipment wherever required shall be at the risk and responsibility of the supplier and payment shall be released only after installation and demonstration of satisfactory working and /or performance of installed equipment.
10. **Warranty:** The equipment shall be covered by a warranty period of one year from the date of its satisfactory installation at consignee's place. During the period of warranty the supplier will provide free servicing and repairs to the equipment. This includes transportation expenditure incurred for such repairs.
11. If an equipment / item supplied is found to have any manufacturing defect and or bad workmanship , the equipment shall be replaced at the sole risk and responsibility of the supplier.
12. **Penalty:** In case the firm fails to supply equipment/item etc. as per the supply order, make/ model/ specifications and within the stipulated period ,the competent authority of the university will be at liberty to impose any penalty, as may be deemed fit in case of such eventuality.
13. **Jurisdictions:** Any dispute arising between the parties (University and suppliers) shall be settled within the jurisdictions of Kashmir Division of J&K State.
